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Historical Retention and Graduation Rates Fall 2009

Executive Summary

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of entering new freshmen and transfers, from one year retention rate to six year graduation rate. Included are Freshmen classes beginning in 1995 and Transfer classes beginning in Fall 2002. The transfer classes are broken down by the classification of the transfer at entry a transfer entering as a freshman will have a very different enrollment pattern than a transfer entering as a senior.
