Retention of Undergraduate Students Fall 2009 to Spring 2010

Executive Summary

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of undergraduate students enrolled in the Fall 2009 term. Using the Banner system, students were classified as enrolled, withdrawn, or graduated for Spring 2010. Those classified as graduated received their degrees in Fall 2009. The tables that follow look at four different

-09 to 2009-10. The overall fall to spring retention rate for undergraduates who did not graduate is 84.9%, down just over four percent For new freshmen, the retention rate is 85.0%, down almost seven percent, while retention for provisionally admitted students dropped almost ten percent. The undergraduate and new freshmen rates are approximately the same as in 2007-08, indicating that the higher 2008-09 rates may have been an anomaly (especially given that there was only a small increase in Fall 2008 to Fall 2009 retention - see Institutional Research report




